It is surrounded by a beautiful park, providing a peaceful and idyllic environment for students to study and learn. The ESC offers comfortable student rooms, classrooms, computer lab, library, and recreational facilities. On-site amenities include free internet access, a laundry room, a breakfast room, a student kitchen, and a lounge.
